**Progress Reports and Kindergarten Communication of Learning**

On Tuesday, November 15, you will be receiving either their Kindergarten Communication of Learning report or their Progress Report if they are in Grades 1-8. These will be distributed electronically through email. Please note the following:

- Reports will be sent on the afternoon of Tuesday November 15.
- Parents/guardians will receive an email from **Toronto District School Board**.
- To open the password-encrypted Report, the password is the student's birthday with the forward slashes (MM/DD/YYYY, Example: **05/03/2004** for the birthdate May 3, 2004).
- The report is emailed to parents/guardians based on the email addresses on record. Please be sure to inform the main office of changes to contact information.
- Please check your junk/spam folders if it does not come to your inbox
- Should you like a paper copy of the report, please ask your child's teacher

These reports let you know early in the school year about your child's progress. For academic subjects like math, language, and science, the progress report tells you whether your child is progressing very well, well, or with difficulty. Progress reports do not have letter grades or percentage marks.

Connected to the November reporting period is the opportunity for families to have a conversation with their child's teacher. Parent/Guardian-Teacher Interviews will be done on Thursday November 17th in the evening and Friday November 18th in the morning. Please note that Friday November 18th is a P.A Day for students. Your child(ren)'s teacher will arrange to have a discussion with you about your child(ren)'s progress.
