#### **Increased Enrollment**

At AMG, we have seen a large increase in our student population. Back in May of 2022 we were projected to have 498 students enrolled from Kindergarten to Grade 8. On our first day of school, on paper, we had 552 registered students. The sudden increase has resulted in some larger than expected classes.

Students continue to register and demit from school so our numbers continue to fluctuate. The TDSB's official count day is Monday, September 19th, the number of students who have registered by that date will be used to determine our classroom organization for the rest of the year.

Based on Ministry of Education requirements and direction from TDSB Employee Services we may need to change class placements. These changes will be completed by October 3rd. Any and all changes will be communicated to affected families and students.

# Office Staffing

We are currently short staffed in the office as we are looking to hire and train a new morning Secretary. Our office Administrator, Michelle Sheehan, who is used to doing the work of 4 people, is capably managing the office but will need a little extra time and patience when answering phones and responding to inquires. Also please note that office staff are on lunch between from 11:30-12:30 PM. Students will be answering the phone and taking messages at that time.

# **Anaphylaxis - Taking the Necessary Precautions**

Anaphylaxis is a serious allergic reaction that can be life threatening. This medical condition can cause a severe reaction to specific foods or other materials, and can result in death within minutes. Although foods such as peanuts, milk, eggs, and sesame seeds are the most common cause of anaphylaxis, insect stings, medicine, or latex can also cause a reaction. In recent years, anaphylaxis has increased dramatically among students.

Although this may or may not affect your child's class directly, we want to raise awareness about this life-threatening condition. Students who have severe allergies to such food substances are exposed to a severe health risk when such products are consumed in their environment or shared with them. As prevention is the best approach, we ask that you speak with your child about not sharing their snacks or lunches with other students and please do not send any snacks or lunches with your child that contain peanuts.

If your child has health problems of any kind, please inform your child's teacher or office staff immediately so that the necessary health protection steps may be taken and to ensure everyone's cooperation for a safe learning environment.

#### Start of Year Forms

This is a friendly reminder to complete the form, 'Start of Year Forms' as soon as possible. These important forms include Medical Information, Consent for Walking Excursions and Use of Online Devices among others. The forms are digital and sent to the email address on file with the school.
