Allergy FAQs

3. What are the priority food allergens in Canada?

Health Canada defines the priority food allergens as: peanut, tree nuts, sesame, milk, egg, fish, crustaceans (e.g., lobster, shrimp) and molluscs (e.g., scallops, clams), soy, wheat and triticale, and mustard. A person can be allergic to any food, but these are the most common. Health Canada's food labelling regulations require the inclusion of the common name of these priority allergens as well as gluten sources and added sulphites on a food label.
