Prevention



Students

- Treat everyone with respect
- Follow school/class expectations
- Be a positive role model
- Help friends solve problems
- Be a helpful bystander

Parents

- Listen and talk regularly with your children
- Appreciate and respect diversity in our school community
- Communicate concerns to school staff and administration

School/Staff

- Develop classroom expectations with students
- Teach bullying prevention strategies
- Teach students how to take action as an effective bystander
- Invite guests/presenters to discuss various forms of bullying

Intervention

Students

- Immediately seek help from school staff when bullying is witnessed or experienced
- Take action as a bystander

Parents

- Immediately seek help when bullying is witnessed or experienced by your child
- Work collaboratively with school staff to resolve problems
- Learn about bullying by attending parent workshops

School/Staff

- Report and communicate all incidents of bullying to parents and staff
- Implement progressive discipline methods
- Offer support to victims and their families

Bullying - is a form of repeated, persistent and aggressive behaviour that is directed at an individual or individuals which is intended to cause fear and distress and/or harm to another person's body, feelings, self-esteem, or reputation. Bullying occurs in a context where there is a real or perceived power imbalance. Bullying behaviour can also take place over the computer through the Internet or on social media websites.
