Credit Rescue Day – Wed Nov 10th

We had a very successful day of learning this week (Thurs. Nov 4th) with our **Credit Rescue Day for Week 1 Courses!** Dozens of students were able to spend quality small group and 1 to 1 time with their teachers to assist them with getting caught up with their classwork. We will continue next week with our **Credit Rescue Day for Week 2 Courses on Wed Nov 10th**.

Just a reminder that on these Credit Rescue Days, **ONLY** students invited to participate by their teachers will be expected to attend school on these days. Students **NOT** engaged in Credit Rescue Activities will be assigned Asynchronous/Independent work that can be completed while they are at home. Students will need to log in to their BrightSpace Classrooms from home during their regularly assigned class times to be marked present for those days. Teachers will be sending out invites to students/families in the days preceding each Credit Rescue Day.

OSSLT Return & Initial Plan

The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test is a province wide assessment that has been put on hold for the last to years due to COVID. The successful completion of the OSSLT will once again become a graduation requirement for students graduating AFTER June 2022. The format of this test has also been adapted to a fully online format, however it must be completed within the school environment (inperson).

With this in mind, the AYJ Literacy Team will be offering two OSSLT completion windows for this school year,

- 1) a **Fall window in late November** for **ALL current grade 11s** and **current grade 12s** with fewer than 22 credits (G12s planning to graduate in June 2022 are **NOT** required to write this year)
- 2) a **Spring window in late March** for **ALL current grade 10s** and those grade 11/12s who still need to fulfill the requirement. Note current grade 9 students will be part of the **2022/23 OSSLT** plan.

Students who fulfill their graduation requirements by June 2022 and decide to return to secondary school for upgrading do **NOT** need to complete the OSSLT requirement.

The AYJ Literacy Team, lead by VP Sukhu and Mr (Mike) Stevens have been working hard to ensure that each eligible student is accounted for and that we are technically prepared for these upcoming days. Grade 11 teachers have been informed which day their class is scheduled to write and eligible students who are not a part of those classes will be given participation instructions directly to them.

From the TDSB re: Flu Shots

This flu season, medical experts are again encouraging individuals to receive a flu vaccine. The flu vaccine is safe to receive alongside the COVID-19 vaccine and others, and getting a flu shot to prevent flu is as important as ever. As we continue to see COVID-19 cases in the community, a flu shot is one of several actions that can help all of us stay healthy and protect those around us. To support this, the West Toronto Ontario Health Team is hosting outdoor flu clinics for community members in the West End of Toronto.
