- 4. School Report** **Principal Paputsis (10 min)**

Discussion Items/Q & A:

-School Update – Synchronous/Asynchronous Expectations (see page 2)

Clear direction has been given that both cohorts are to join their teacher everyday.

There should be 225 minutes of instruction in the morning. A minimum of 150 minutes will be online together, synchronously, engaging and learning. 75 minutes may be asynchronous. Afternoon classes are 75 minutes long, entirely synchronous, both cohorts together. Teachers have flexibility to determine when the morning 75 minute asynchronous will take place, but all teachers will start at 8:45am.

This quad there will be 11 Day1-4 cycles, 22 mornings and 21 afternoons, the last 2 days are credit rescue days. Credit rescue days happen throughout the quad for students to redo course work to pass the class. This is to help students avoid repeating classes.

-Quad 4 Staffing Update

-Remote Setting School Restrictions (grads/proms, etc)

There are a lot of restrictions around bringing students to the building. There may be a second pick up for resources.

There has not been a formal return of textbooks and materials from Quad 3. Plans for this will come out if school does not return.

At this time grad and prom gatherings are cancelled. A virtual Commencement is considered for the end of June.

-2021/22 Staffing/Student Timetabling Process

i) student selections

ii) teacher allocation – two math teachers will join the school and some Long Term Occasional teachers were able to continue from Quad 3.

iii) school scheduling (student & teacher)

Planning for next year, Sept 2021. Student enrolment is predicted to be 1100.

Projection for next year is 59.5 Full time equivalent teachers. Based on student selections, staffing committee consultation and seniority, four teachers are surplus to AYJ. These teachers will be reallocated throughout the board. The next step is to schedule students into their classes. Currently, school formats are unknown for next year, for example whether school will be in quads, virtual etc.

In June, Guidance tries to allow students a “sneak preview” of their courses for the next year. This is again the goal. Throughout the summer, schedules are usually available through the School Connects app.

To begin **Quadmester 4**, we will revert to our previous **FULLY REMOTE** teaching and learning model. In the morning, students will have at least 150 minutes of **SYNCHRONOUS** online instruction and no more than 75 minutes of **ASYNCHRONOUS** independent work between 8:45am and 12:30pm. Individual teachers will share specific details with each of their classes. In the afternoon, students will be engaged in 75 minutes of **SYNCHRONOUS** online instruction.
