Students must fulfill the following criteria:

- 1) Successfully complete ICS20, ICS3U and ICS4U and achieve a minimum of 90% in each of the grade 11 (3U) and grade 12 (4U) courses
- 2) Participate in the University of Waterloo Canadian Computing Competition (CCC) in grade 11 and in grade 12, achieve a Certificate of Distinction (top 25%) result in the senior division of CCC or reach the regional final at the ECOO Programming Contest
- 3) Be an active member of the programming club by:
 - a) Attending meetings regularly
 - b) Participating in the Tech Day and Curriculum Nights – create and facilitate activities for incoming students
 - c) Grade 12 – planning and running training sessions for junior members, or tutoring students with difficulty in CS courses
