Good day AYJ Community,

After an event packed November, it was great to ease into the start to December! We will be picking up the pace next week and beyond leading us into the Winter Break.

Please take the time to review the items below:

AYJ Entry Student School Entry Protocol

We want to remind ALL students that while we no longer have the mandate to physically scan every QR code upon entry in favour of a visual scan by the adults at the entry points, we will be checking to make sure that the code presented is "stamped" with the current date for entry. This means that **ALL** students need to sign in **EACH** day with a <u>fresh submission</u> in order to get the date populated on their QR code. The wifi at the entry points can get wonky so our advice is to complete the survey at home, screenshot with the current date showing and present the screenshot at entry.

Trial Period for the Temporary/Daily Use of am/pm Classroom Based Lockers – Grade 9s

The initial results from our first week trial was the realization that our students did NOT choose to access these units very much. We will continue to monitor this usage before we expand the Temporary/Daily Use of am/pm Classroom Based Lockers Plan.

Key Points to the Plan,

Students accessing these lockers from this classroom MUST:

a) Bring their **OWN** personal lock

(these can be purchased in the main office – see link below) https://tdsb.schoolcashonline.com/Fee/Details/112818/153/False/True

 b) Vacate their contents at the end of the morning by 11:45am for their morning class OR

by the end of the afternoon by 3:00pm for their afternoon class

c) Wipe down the inside of lockers with cleaning wipes

(provided by the classroom teacher)

d) Lockers CANNOT be shared with another classmate

Locks that remain on lockers **AFTER 3pm** will be **CUT off** and locker contents will be brought to the main office for recovery.

Sem 1 Marks Maintain Date (for Senior Courses)

For students taking **SENIOR LEVEL** courses (Gr 11 & Gr 12), please know that recent changes by the Ministry of Education have pushed back the date of the Marks Maintain Date (MMD) to Dec 15th (previously it was 5 days after the transmission of the mid term report card – Nov 26th).

So what is the significance of the November 26th date versus the new MMD (now December 15)?

If a student is seeking an early acceptance to a university, and they are doing well in three courses and poorly in one course, they may elect to drop the course where they are under-performing by November 26 so that a "bad" mark does not appear on their records and jeopardize their chance for an early acceptance.

However, if a student is not expecting to receive an early admittance and needs to continue to work towards achieving a certain mark in a course, they may elect to keep that course and continue working on it until the last possible date to drop it (now December 15). At that point, the student can determine whether to keep the course or drop it. If they drop the course, the mid-term mark will have been transmitted to the universities, however the mark and the course will not appear on the student's final report card.
