

TDSB schools no longer accept emails declaring "No Offences/No Convictions".

If you have previously completed a Police Reference Check, please complete the <u>Volunteer Annual Offence</u> <u>Declaration</u> form (linked via our school website) and send it to the school office to be processed.

Grade 7 Parent Welcome Night


