

2025 WARD 11 BY-ELECTION

The Ward 11 by-election is just around the corner! Election day is Monday, March 3, with advance voting taking place February 22 and 23. Eligible voters can also register for Mail-in Voting before February 6.

Residents in TDSB Ward 11 can vote for your Trustee if you are a Canadian citizen, at least 18 years old, and a public school supporter. Eligible voters are encouraged to use MyVote to confirm you are on the voters' list, add or update your voter information, check where you vote, and more.

You can vote for Trustee, TD\$B Ward 11 (Don Valley West) if you are:

- · an English public school supporter; and
- · a Canadian citizen; and
- · at least 18 years old; and
- a resident in TDSB Ward 11; or
- a non-resident in the city of Toronto, but you or your spouse own or rent residential property in TDSB Ward 11;
- · not prohibited from voting under any law.

Get on the voters' list before 4:30 p.m. on February 6 at toronto.ca/MyVote.

Vote by Mail

Apply to vote by mail before 4:30 p.m. on February 6 at toronto.ca/VoteByMail or call 311 to learn more.

Once your Mail-in Voting application is processed you will be sent a package. Completed packages must be received by February 24 at noon (12 p.m.).

Vote in Person

Vote early during the advance voting weekend on February 22 and 23 from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

You can vote at one of two voting places:

- York Mills Collegiate Institute, 490 York Mills Rd.
- Marc Garneau Collegiate Institute, 135 Overlea Blvd.

Election day is Monday, March 3
