CLASSROOM ORGANIZATION 2024–2025

Each year the board sends schools their projected enrolment and staff allocation in the spring for the following school year. Numbers include direction for the number of kindergartens, number of primary staff, and number for grade 4–8 staff. Class size caps are set for grade 1–3 at 20 and grade 3/4 at 23. Bessborough's school model will be shared in mid-April with families after consultation with staff, the school council and approval by the board.
