

100th Anniversary-Looking for Committee Members

Did you know that Bessborough is celebrating its 100th Anniversary this year? Bessborough was the first school to be opened in Leaside and originally opened in December 1923. The original school building consisted of 4 classrooms and, also, housed municipal offices in the basement. February is African Heritage Month

During the month of February, the Toronto District School Board proudly recognizes African Heritage Month. It is an occasion to celebrate the many achievements and contributions of peoples of African descent to Canada and the world. The first Black Canadian woman elected to Parliament, the Honourable Jean Augustine, introduced a motion to recognize February as Black History Month. The motion was carried unanimously by the House of Commons. In December 1995, the House of Commons officially recognized February as Black History Month in Canada. At the Toronto District School Board, a motion to recognize African Heritage (Black History) Month was carried in January 2002 and reaffirmed again in January 2004. At Bessborough, students are engaged in learning about Black leaders in Canadian society. As well, daily announcements will feature stories about African Canadians and African proverbs.

February is Chinese Heritage Month

The Toronto District School Board is proud to recognize Chinese Heritage Month (CHM) during the month of February 2023. This year marks the Year of the Rabbit, which began on Sunday, January 22, 2023. At TDSB, the theme *Year of the Rabbit: Kind, Generous, and Harmonious* is being celebrated. This year, the Chinese Heritage Committee selected a second theme: *Honouring a Legacy of Conviction and Fortitude* to mark the 100th anniversary of the *Chinese Immigration Act of 1923* (known as the Chinese Exclusion Act). This Act restricted all people of Chinese descent from immigrating into Canada for 24 years with only 15 Chinese immigrants allowed entry into Canada from 1923 to 1946. Parliament officially repealed the act on May 14, 1947 and in 2006, the Government of Canada issued an official apology to Chinese Canadians; Chinese Immigration Act, 1923. At Bessborough, students will be engaged in learning about Chinese leaders and their contributions to Canadian society in the classroom and through the daily announcements.

- Final round
 - Deadline for parents/guardians of students to be informed of the status of the Out-of-Area Application (February 22, 2023)
 - Deadline for families to confirm acceptance of the Out-of-Area offer (February 24, 2023)
- Students must finalize their destination for secondary school (designated school by address, Central Program, Alternative School, Out-of-Area Admission) by completing and submitting the corresponding course selection for the accepted school in myBlueprint (February 27, 2023)
