

EQAO: Grade 3 and Grade 6

From Monday June 29th until Friday, June 9th, our grade 3 and 6 students will participate in the Assessment of Reading, Writing and Mathematics, Primary/Junior Division: 2023. Teachers will be preparing students for the writing of the assessments this coming week. The results of the assessments will be returned to parents in the Fall of 2023. Tests will be scheduled in the mornings. If possible, please postpone any doctor/dentist appointments you may be scheduling on the testing dates. In this way, your child will not miss any part of the assessment, will not have to make up the missed assessment, and will feel encouraged to do their best. Class Organization for the 2023-2024 School Year

Class organization for September is based on enrolment numbers and staff allocation. There will be some changes in staffing and teaching responsibilities for the upcoming 2023-2024 school year. Final assignments for teachers remain tentative. Teachers at each grade level and the principal will meet to develop equitable and balanced instructional groupings based on several factors including a balanced ratio of boys and girls, a balance of academic levels and needs, and group dynamics. There are many variables that are considered for each child when they are placed into a class. Parents may wish to have input into the decision by sharing additional information about their child's learning needs. Should you wish to offer further insights, please submit them in writing to Ms. Bambrick no later than Friday, May 26. In the email outline the learning needs and special concerns about your child for your request. Requesting specific teachers or requesting the names of specific groups of students in a class cannot be honoured. Please be aware that while your request will be considered, we cannot guarantee a specific placement and staff must make the final decisions in the best interests of all students.

This is a reminder that the Grade 8 Grad has been moved to Thursday, June 22nd due to the municipal by-election on June 26th. The Grad will be held at Leaside in the auditorium. More details will be sent soon from Grade 8 homeroom teachers.

Pediculosis Screening at Bessborough: May 25 in the PM

We have had an increase in head lice in the school. We will have the TDSB Pediculosis Nurse in the school on Wednesday, May 25th in the afternoon to check students in Kindergarten to Grade 3/4 (Ms. Standing's Class). For families who do not wish to have their child checked at school please let the office or your child's teacher know and we ask that you check your child's head at home. This will help to stop the spread.

Here are helpful tips to stop the spread of head lice from Toronto Public Health:

- Teach your child(ren) how head lice are spread.
- Discourage head-to-head contact and sharing of hats, scarves, hairbrushes, and combs.
- Tie long hair back in braids.
- Check the head of young school age children weekly for head lice; more often if there is an outbreak.
- Routinely check the heads of all people living in the household for head lice.
- Treat all people with head lice in the household at the same time.
- If someone in your household has head lice, tell all people who have close contact with the person with head lice to check their heads, including the child's teacher and/or daycare worker.
