School Update (Ms. Borselli)

- ECE removal in 1 Kindergarten Class
 - o 1 large class of 26 and 1 small class of 14 for kindergarten
- Report Cards

- Photo day retake is on November 8th
 - Photo were done in October
- Evacuation Plan
 - School conducting an evacuation practice day
 - There are 3 locations for evacuation
 - The evacuation plan is in preparation for emergency such as Flood, Danger, Fire, etc.
