By participating in our **Walk for Water** we all have the opportunity to raise awareness of this provincial and national issue in Canada.

BPCI will walk in unison with another school in Calgary, Alberta who will be walking as well on April 27th. We have also invited our feeder schools to take part by holding their own walk at their school.

BCPI is focused on raising awareness around Indigenous communities in Canada without access to safe, clean water. In one of the most water rich countries in the world, approximately one out of every five first Nations communities in Canada lacks access to clean, safe and sustainable drinking water. Everyone in Canada has a right to clean drinking water.

BPCI will be fundraising in support of WE Walk for Water and are asking students to donate a loonie or toonie on Friday, April 27. Proceeds will go to <u>Water First</u> which is a registered Canadian charity that addresses water challenges in First Nations communities through education, training, and meaningful collaboration.

SEMESTER 2 30% SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT

Important school polices regarding the 30% component for each subject is outlined in the Student Agenda on pages 34 – 36.

30% of the final course mark is determined in the final weeks of the course.

Final Culminating Activities begin May 22 and continue until the final exam period.

Culminating tasks, assignments and assessment are compulsory components for each subject. It is important that students meet key timelines and due dates.

JUNE EXAMS

- Final June Exams will be scheduled June 19 26.
- The Exam Schedule will be available towards the end of May and will be posted on the school website.
- Each student will be provided a copy of their own exam schedule.
- Final Exams are compulsory for all students. There are no exemptions.
- A medical note is required if the student is not well enough to write an exam on a specific date.

We ask parents and guardians to call the school and speak to the Principal or Vice-Principals regarding specific concerns that they may have regarding final June exams.
