#### Time to arrive at school

- 1. Front Entrance:
  - a. Line 1 = Grade 9 ONLY line for all our Grade 9s (Express VIP Service)
  - b. Line 2 = Grades 10-12
- 2. East Entrance: Lines 3 and 4 (both lines for grades 10-12)

#### **Student Timetables**

### Quad 1 Cohort A

Our first day Thursday Sept. 17, 2020 is a DAY 1 Quad 1so Cohort A will be attending in person at school from 8:45am to 12:30pm. At 12:30pm students will leave the building and make their way home, have lunch and prepare for their Live Virtual Learning period from 2:00pm -3:15pm.

#### Quad 1 Cohort B

Students who are in Cohort B are <u>not</u> to come to school on Thursday Sept. 17 as they are required to do their assigned Independent Learning at home in the morning from 8:45am to 12:30 pm and then their Live Virtual Learning from 2:00pm - 3:15 pm. Students who are in Cohort B for Quad 1 will come to school on Friday morning DAY 2.
