

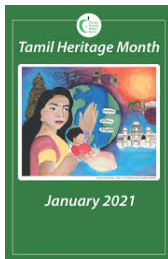

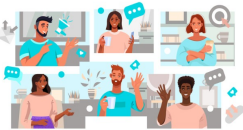
Student Success and Gifted

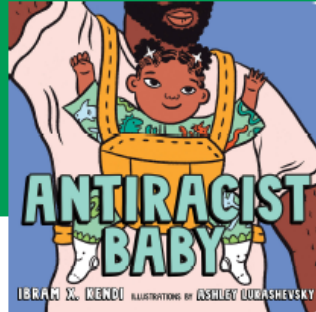
