Student Engagement during the Lockdown: All Virtual Learning is Not Created Equal

We are in lockdown until Jan,. 25th, 2021 and as a result we are all actively engaged in a virtual learning environment. It is important that we note that the virtual learning environment is very different than last Spring when the pandemic first hit us.

Virtual Learning - Spring 2020

In the Spring 2020 students' marks could not decrease during the virtual learning period. In other words, if you went into the lockdown in March 2020 if you mark was at 75% at the time of the lockdown your mark could only improve by the end of the year in June 2020.

Virtual Learning NOW- January 2021

That is not true during this virtual learning period. Student attendance is required, participation is required, submitting work is required and all classroom activities will help the student to be successful in earning their credit. If students are not attending and submitting work for evaluation it will negatively impact their ability to achieve the desired marks. Our staff will be reaching out to make sure that your child is engaged and is on track to earn their credit. If your child is not actively engaged in virtual learning over the next few weeks during the lockdown please reach out to your child's teacher, guidance counsellor or our Administration team for support.

These are challenging times for all of us. But we are committed to ensuring that every child, no matter what challenges they face, has an opportunity to be successful in earning all of their credits.

Students and parents should now have access to midterms marks. You can access marks by logging into Teach Assist using your students username and password. Parents do not have a separate login account. Similar to quadmester one, for the second quadmester, there will not be formal parent/guardian-teacher conferences. For our grade 12 students, marks will be transmitted to OCAS/OUAC by February 15.
