Report Cards

This week you would have received your child's first term report card. The first term elementary provincial report card (for the period of September 2018 to January 2019) is designed to report on your child's achievement of curriculum expectations and development of the learning skills and academic progress. Comments that highlight your child's strengths and next steps for improvement are also included in the report card from your child's teacher.

The achievement of curriculum expectations (located on pages 2 and 3) for your child is reported on using letter grades for Grades 1-6. The report on your child's achievement also includes comments that describe your child's strengths, what they know and can do, and where appropriate, next steps for improvement. The achievement for the provincial curriculum expectations (page 4) provides the definitions of the four levels of achievement.

If you are interested in meeting with your child's teacher(s) to discuss your child's progress, but have not yet done so, please note that you can set up an interview at any time. The home school relationship is very important in supporting student achievement and school success. As parents and caregivers, you are important allies supporting in class learning and behaviours.

Kindergarten Registration

Once this portion of the registration is completed, you will still need to come in person to complete the process; you will need two proofs of address, birth certificate or passport, health card, and immunization records. For those getting ready to register for French Immersion Kindergarten, the in-person paper is the same for French as it is for English. Our French immersion Kindergarten registration week is taking place the week of March 4-8. Again, we ask that you come in to register in the afternoons.
