#### EarlyON Centre at Blake Street JPS:

This letter is to inform you that the EarlyON Child and Family Centre at Blake Street JPS will be closing on Thursday, June 27, 2019 due to the need for more classroom space. We are aware of the centre's strong and important history with the school and value the support that the community has offered the program over many years.

The placement of an EarlyON Centre in a school is based on a number of variables, including available space. Consideration is also given to the availability of alternate early years services in the community to support early learning. Periodically, the placement of EarlyON Centres is reviewed by TDSB staff in consultation with Toronto Children Services.

### Where are the closest EarlyON Centres to Blake Jr PS?

This community is fortunate to have a number of alternate early year's programs within the neighbourhood and we encourage you to take advantage of these options. Your closest TDSB EarlyON Centre is located at Pape Ave Junior Public School (220 Langley Avenue, Room 8) and is open Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Families can also access the Eastview EarlyON Child and Family Centre (86 Blake Street), which is open Monday to Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Please see the chart below for a full listing of EarlyON Centres in your Ward.
