If you have not yet completed the online portion of the kindergarten registration which can be accessed at www.tdsb.on.ca/kindergarten please do so at your earliest convenience. Should you require the use of a computer, come to the office.

Once this portion of the registration is completed, you will still need to come in person to complete the process, and you will need two proofs of address, birth certificate or passport, health card, immunization records. For those registering for French Immersion Kindergarten, your online portion was completed when you initially registered in the fall, and was completed when you accepted. You are still required to complete the in person paper work.

We ask that you do so in the afternoons as Ms. Scott is by herself in the mornings.
