Winter Recess Times

Elementary school students are kept indoors for recess and lunch times for a number of weather conditions such as rain, lightning in the area, extreme winds and extreme cold. When temperature and wind chill measure -28C or lower, students are kept indoors. However, recesses and the lunch hour may be shortened if the temperature and wind chill reading is between -28C and -20C; recesses for 10 minutes and lunch recess for 20 minutes. Please make sure your child is dressed for the winter weather. Students need to wear extra layers of clothing, boots, hats, mitts and scarves. Bring extra socks in case your feet get wet. Keep in mind that our students love to play outside in the snow building forts and snow creations!
