As a staff, we are proud of the performance of our students, and we will strive to continue to improve the results for this upcoming school year. Our results are as follows in terms of percentage of students achieving levels 3 and 4: Grade 3 Reading – 94.8% Grade 3 Writing – 94.8% Grade 3 Mathematics – 95.1%

Grade 6 Reading – 95.4% Grade 6 Writing – 95.3% Grade 6 Mathematics – 95.3%

Each year, Halloween is marked in a variety of ways in school communities across the TDSB. Students can

Any forms of weapons are not allowed at Blythwood. **Please do not send individual treats with your child to share with his/her classmates**. Blythwood is an allergen aware school and NUT free. We have many students with allergies and dietary restrictions.
