#### **Kindergarten Registration for September 2025**



Children who will be four by December 31, 2025, can start Junior Kindergarten in September 2025. Learn more about <u>Kindergarten at the TDSB</u>, <u>Before- and After-School Programs</u> and <u>Extended Day Programs</u>.

### Register for English Kindergarten

Registration for English Kindergarten programs will begin in January 2025. We look forward to welcoming you and your child!

- Only parents or legal quardians can register a child.
- There is a separate process to apply for <u>out-of-area admissions</u>. Please contact <u>alternative schools</u> or <u>elementary academies</u> directly for more information.
- If your child currently attends child care at a TDSB school that is not your designated home school, and you wish to register for Kindergarten at that school, an out-of-area admissions application may not be required. Please review the Out of Area Admissions Policy and Procedure and, if eligible, proceed with the in-person registration option outlined below.

#### **Early French Immersion**

The Early French Immersion program begins in Junior Kindergarten (JK). **Families who wish to have their child participate in an Early French Immersion Program must apply in November 2024.** To apply, please visit <a href="https://www.tdsb.on.ca/pars">www.tdsb.on.ca/pars</a>.

For September 2025 entry, the application process closed on November 29, 2024. Applications submitted after the deadline will be marked as late and accommodated if space in the program is available.

In February, only those families who applied in November and have accepted an offer of placement for their child via the <u>central application process</u> can register for Early French Immersion.
