How to Order:

Ordering for all three dates will open on Monday, October 7 through Lunchbox.

Lunchbox is accessed through your existing School Cash Online account.

Lunchbox allows parents to:

- Order pizza for an individual date OR for multiple dates at one time
- Orders can be cancelled up until 2 business days before pizza lunch for a credit to your account (**Note this is not a refund but a credit for a future pizza lunch!)
- Lunchbox has a support team for signup or ordering issues available to you Monday to Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. by phone at 1.877.426.6860 or by email at info@lunchboxorders.com

How to set up Lunchbox first time users:

- 1. Log into your SchoolCash Online account as you would normally.
- 2. Select ITEMS from the top right menu bar
- You will see the following banner above each child(rens) name(s). Click ORDER NOW. This will take you to the Lunchbox ordering platform. YOU MUST DO THIS FOR EACH STUDENT SEPARATELY going back to SchoolCash Online each time.
- 4. Your child(ren) will pre-populate in the lunchbox system however, you need to complete the profile. Complete your child(rens) profile with your phone number and any allergy information select ADD/Update.
- 5. Make sure all children in your household have been added to Lunchbox THEN: You will see your child(rens) name(s) and an ORDER NOW button, which will take you to the ordering calendar to place your order.
- 6. Orders for each child are placed separately via their own order calendar.

Admission: While admission to the Early French Immersion (JK entry) or Middle French Immersion (Grade 4 entry) programs is guaranteed at the entry points to all eligible on-time applicants, admission to a specific school is <u>NOT</u> guaranteed. Applications to begin these programs are open to all students not already enrolled in a French program.

Transportation: Where transportation is approved by the Transportation Department, students meeting the distance criteria for Kindergarten to Grade 5 will be transported by bus, and students from Grades 6 to 8 will be provided with TTC tickets, where applicable.

University of Toronto's Stars for Scholarly Youth (SSY) Tteam Free Tutoring - One-on-One Tutoring

This year, we are running a free 1-on-1 tutoring and mentoring program in order to provide free academic resources to students.

Our tutoring program provides educational support through free tutoring services offered directly from SSY. Tutors are outstanding University of Toronto students who go through SSY's tutor training program and undergo a police check upon request. Our tutoring services are one-on-one and are usually offered once per week for an hour, however, this may be adjusted based on the needs of the student. This program is available to students in Grades 5 - 12 with financial need and those who are refugees, new immigrants, in foster homes, shelters and more.
