#### What is an Extended Day Program?

An Extended Day Program (EDP) provides seamless learning for children from Kindergarten to Grade 6 who require care before school starts and at the end of the school day. Children will develop skills such as collaboration, responsibility, problem-solving, creativity, citizenship and leadership through interesting activities. Extended Day Programs will be delivered by TDSB staff including a Designated Early Childhood Educator. Children will receive two nutritious snacks per day.

#### **Central Student Interest Programs: Applications**

The application for admission in September 2025 in TDSB Central Student Interest Programs (CSIP) opens on Monday, November 4 and closes at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, November 22, 2024.

Students in Grades 3 - 10 can submit one application for admission into a Central Student Interest Program. Each applicant selects one primary program for their application, and has the option of including an alternate choice. Alternate choices will only be considered after all primary applications from the city of Toronto have been considered.

Secondary offers will continue to be made in 2025 until February 26, 2025. Elementary offers will continue until February 27, 2025.

No offers will be made after these dates and all <u>Central Waitlists</u> will expire on these respective dates.

#### **Early French Immersion Application Process**

The entry point to Early French Immersion is Junior Kindergarten.

Early French Immersion (Junior Kindergarten Entry) Application Deadline - For families interested in the Toronto District School Board's system-wide French Immersion Program, we offer an online process to apply for Early French Immersion (begins in JK). To apply to the Early French Immersion Program for September 2025, applications must be completed online between November 4 and November 29, 2024. Families with an older sibling currently in an Early French Immersion program at the same school are still required to complete an online application for the new student.
