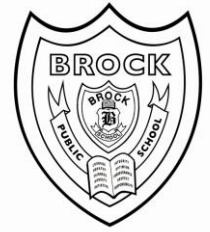


Brock Jr. Public School, Toronto 125th Anniversary Celebrations



Brock Public School is a Kindergarten to Grade 8 community based elementary school located near Dufferin and College. The school opened in 1887 with 202 students and 4 teachers.

The school's first principal was Alexander Muir (author of The Maple Leaf Forever). The present building was constructed in 1919 with an extension in 1938. Brock School sits in the heart of the diverse and vibrant Brockton neighbourhood. Waves of immigration from different parts of the world helped shape the neighbourhood and the school over the last 125 years.

Brock continues to grow and adapt to the times: a dynamic library with a smart board, a new roof garden and partnership with Food Share, the addition of grades 7 & 8, the expansion of the gym – makes Brock an exciting place to learn!
