

Important Policies and Information



Reorganization: Due to increased registration, class reorganization is possible. We hope to provide families an update in late September.

September Forms: Please review the September package that was sent home the first day carefully. The white pages are information for you. All forms on <u>coloured</u> paper need be completed and each section must be signed. Completed forms should be returned to the school by **Friday, September 14, 2018** at the latest. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to call our office at 416-393-9245 or contact your child's teacher.

Nut Free Policy: Also in the package that was sent home, we ask parents to report any severe allergies that your child has. If your child requires an Epi-Pen, please ensure that you provide the classroom/office with one that we may use in case of an emergency. **This is also a reminder to all parents that foods that contain nuts or nut products are strictly prohibited.**

Drop off and Pick Up: A friendly reminder that all parents are asked not to wait indoors with their children or walk them to their classroom during any time of the day. Parents should also not wait in the hallways/stairwells at the end of the day. This will greatly assist in reducing congestion, which helps us to ensure the safety of our students. If you need to speak to a teacher, please make an appointment with them through the office or use the method of communication shared by your child's teacher.

Supervision: We would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that teacher supervision of students in the playground begins at 8:35 a.m. in the mornings and lasts until 3:43 p.m. in the afternoon. Please ensure that a parent/guardian is present with your child before and after these times. <u>All students must leave school grounds at the end of the day, unless they are supervised by a parent or adult.</u>

Safe Arrival: Please phone the office at 416-393-9245 if your child is going to be absent. If your child is late to school, they must come to the office to receive a late slip. We encourage everyone to be at school on time to maximize learning and avoid disruptions to the class. Parents are also reminded to please visit the office first when dropping off lunches, picking students up for appointments, etc. Thank you for your support!

Attendance Policy: Once students have enrolled in school, the expectation is that they will be at school and on time each day. There is a strong positive correlation between regular school attendance and both academic and social success at school. If there is a pattern of lates or absences, expect a call from the teacher and/or the office. For lates or absences exceeding 15 days, it is the board policy to send an attendance letter home, potentially followed by an 'attendance referral' which is initiated with the school's Social Worker. You are encouraged to contact the Principal if there are circumstances preventing your child from being at school regularly and/or on time.

Emergency Procedures: We are required to have six practice Fire Drills (three in the Fall, three in the Spring) and two practice Lockdown drills each year.

Communication: Classroom teachers often have active classroom websites and/or communicate through classroom newsletters and student agendas (grades 1-8). The school office also sends home important notices. Please read everything carefully.

Process for Communicating Concerns:

Q N

- 1. **Speak with the Classroom Teacher** (academic, social, program questions/concerns- a discussion and plan to address the concern should take place (parent & teacher)
- 2. Re-Visit with Teacher- revisit if plan is not working and revise plan together
- 3. Talk to Admin-request administrator (Principal) meeting (admin & parent/guardian)
- Teacher + Admin + Parent- parent/guardian, teacher, admin, possibly support staff)

This is intended to be a <u>"positive-solutions based"</u> process. It requires that you know what your goal is going into the communication. Everyone (students, parents, staff) wants to be successful and feel supported.

Students should line up at their designated doors in a quiet and orderly manner. They should not enter via the front door, except when they are late and must get a late slip.


