## Meeting Minutes:

### Message from the Principal

- The staffing model has been updated, as per projections, there are 2 Grade 1 classes. Projections may change with additional students.
- Allocation received so far include are 2 lunch room supervisors, 1 EA and 1 staff allocated in the office. Three teachers are on leave next year and those positions to be filled in.
- School survey was sent twice to the parents to get their feedback. Requests to be considered.
- The grade 5 graduation is scheduled on 27<sup>th</sup> June likely at 10 in the morning. Scheduled to take place in the gym. Gym has a maximum capacity of 140 numbers if chairs are put in as per safety standard.
- The requirements from the school for the spring fair include tables, chairs, extension cords, speakers and electricity.

### Fundraising events

- Book Bazaar update: To be conducted at the spring fair instead of a separate event. If there are any balance books to be sold at the Spring concert.
- The number of orders for lunch lady have been comparatively less hence brainstorming ideas on how to increase sales were discussed. Suggestions given were: to change the day instead of Monday or look for another vendor with better menu options or opt for a sub day instead of lunch lady.
- Spring fair update: Since there are shortage of tables Pat has suggested to check with Churchhill and Willodale
