Meeting Minutes:

Message from the Principal

- Teachers are working on the First term report cards using a brand-new POWER SCHOOL system. They are currently working through the initial glitches.
- Safe school teams launched, and two students will be part of the committee.
- Swipe card systems are being developed for daycare, and a phone system is used to buzz students in—updates to be provided shortly.
- After the March break, the school would receive the allocation for the teaching staff. Therefore, there is a possibility of changes in the staff allocation.
- Teachers have started planning the field trips for students, and it has been confirmed that grade 1 will be visiting Ripley's aquarium.

Fundraising events

- A list of all the upcoming events was shared in the meeting, including Pizza lunches, Pizza night, Smoothies, Holiday cards, valentine Candy grams, Cookie dough fundraiser Bingo/candy kababs, Book bazaar, Spring Fair, Book Fair, and Clothing/toy drive.
- The pizza night fundraiser will be announced soon and scheduled for the third week of February. The price of each pizza would be around 26 Dollars, and 5 Dollars would go as proceeds to the school council—more Pizza night fundraisers to be initiated in the future.
- Valentine's day candy gram Loot bags will be sold at 2.5 Dollars and 1.5 dollars as proceeds to the school council funds.
- Cookie dough fundraiser to be planned for April during Easter. Prices would be around 4 to 6 Dollars.
- Book Bazaar event to be handled by Kate and Janice.
- Spring fair updates Subcommittees have been formed, and more volunteers are needed. Currently, there are 14 members, and Melissa will forward the info folder shortly.
