### **Meeting Minutes:**

### Message from the Principal

- Staff numbers and teacher's allocation are being prepared for the next school year. The Number of students is at 215, and 18.5 teachers.
- The realignment process starts in September, where new classes are added or teachers be added/removed.
- For the library, allocation has not yet been received as well as the school staff allocation.
- School council members can suggest their inputs towards the school model and can reach out the principal. He shall share the parameters to them directly.
- Class room set up notification will be sent and the draft is being prepared. Parents can request 2 kids to be in same class, only if parents of both students agree. The Request will be taken into due consideration before finalising the list.
- The roof of the school is under renovation and expected to be completed in a few months

### Fundraising events

- Cookie dough fundraiser is planned for 3<sup>rd</sup> April during Easter. Aastha confirmed that 75 orders were received. It will be delivered to the school and distributed near the gym.
- Book Bazaar update: Tentative date to be decided shortly.
