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5. Principal's report

H. Bieler reported on various items including:

- Harvest food bank Total weight 1300 pounds or 589.67 kilos; last year was 425 kilo's which is a 38% increase in our collection (partly due to more students)
- Lice Checks 5 students in one grade 1 class.
- Activities: Lunch Skilz workshops 3 workshops servicing appx. 60 students. Grade 3 Reading Club Days 1,3 & 4. (Ms. W.E.) Boys' Grade 4/5 Basketball. Silver Birch reading program. Appx. 10-12 gr. 4/5 students. Every Wednesday during AM recess. They check in, share their ideas about the books they have read, and get new books. They also have activity packages with different sheets connected to each book to work on when they are finished. The voting takes place in April. Any student who has read at least 5 of the 10 books is eligible to vote. The awards are given out at Harbourfront Centre in May. (Beatty). Eco club Thursday's 2x's per month PALS Leaders PM recess on Tuesdays and Thursdays run activities for Grades 1,2 and 3 (rotates) in the gym, supervised by teachers.
- Teamwork Assembly will be on Friday, January 30th at 9:10 am
- Tech: After discussion with the ICT committee about future capacity building of technology in our school, it was decided that we purchase Ipads for student use (10 Ipad Air's with Apple Care and protective devices ~\$6,000). We are able to do this from some budget carry over from last year. Purchase existing set of MCS-2.0 Netbooks the 3 year term is up as of June. (Total cost ~4,800)
