

# September: Singing and Playing Music

By the end of Grade 3, students will:

- sing, in tune, unison songs, partner songs, and rounds

'Unison' means instruments are playing (or voices are singing) the same pitch

'Round' means a piece for three or more voices or instruments in which each sings or plays the same melodic material but starts one after the other at a set point

- and/or play accompaniments from a wide variety of diverse cultures, styles, and historical periods

'Accompaniment' means a part that supports a voice or instrument, like a guitar playing music during a song



Examples:

- sing or play an instrument accompanied by body percussion or found sounds
- sing or play a rhythmic or melodic ostinato

'Ostinato' is a continuous repeated rhythmic or melodic pattern
