September: Singing and Playing Music

By the end of Grade 5, students will:

sing and/or play, in tune, from musical notation, unison and two-part music with accompaniments, from a wide variety of cultures, styles, and historical periods

'Unison' means instruments are playing (or voices are singing) the same pitch






'Accompaniment' means a part that supports a voice or instrument, like a guitar playing music during a song

Examples:

perform a recorder duet that has a variety of rhythmic and melodic patterns



'Duet' means a performance by two people
