## **Castlebar Junior School - Frequently Asked Questions**

## When will Castlebar Junior School open?

The school is scheduled to open September 2019.

#### What is the catchment area for Castlebar Junior School?

## Will Castlebar Junior School be a Kindergarten to Grade 3 school?

Castlebar Junior School will be K-3 for the 2019-2020 school year. However, the school will grow to become a K-4 school in the 2020-2021 school year and become a K-5 school in the 2021-2022 school year. There-in-after 2021, Castlebar Junior School will remain a Kindergarten to Grade 5 school.

## Where will my child attend school after grade 5?

Upon completion of grade 5 at Castlebar Junior School, students will attend Norseman Junior Middle School for grades 6-8.

## When will registration for Castlebar Junior School open?

Registration is presently open for students who live in the Castlebar Junior School catchment area. You are welcome to drop by the school to register your child if you are new to the area or if you have a child in Junior Kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school year.

If your child presently attends Kindergarten to Grade 2 at Norseman Junior Middle School and lives in the Castlebar Junior School catchment area you **will not** need to register your child at Castlebar Junior School for the 2019 school year. Your child will automatically be transferred over to Castlebar Junior School, for your convenience.

# Can my child remain at Norseman Junior School even though I live in the Castlebar Junior School catchment area?

Norseman Junior Middle School is closed for optional attendance in the 2019-2020 school year. Children from Kindergarten to Grade 3 in the Castlebar catchment area will attend Castlebar Junior School for the 2019-2020 school year.

## Will Castlebar Junior School be open for optional attendance?

Castlebar Junior School will be closed for optional attendance in the 2019-2020 school year. The TDSB will review the optional attendance status on an annual basis.

## Which specialized programs will be available when Castlebar Junior School opens?

Castlebar Junior school will offer a regular program. Specialized programs may be considered in the future.
