International Languages – Elementary and African Programs

In an increasingly globalized world, it is important to set our students on the path to being active global citizens. Open to all students from Kindergarten to Grade 8, the International Language program offers language learning with engaging activities like games and songs. No language background is necessary.

In the African Heritage program, JK to Grade 8 students will explore the history, culture, traditions and contributions that people of African descent have made to Canada and the world.

The classes are offered once a week either after school or on the weekends from September 2022 to June 2023 for 2.5 hours each class. The classes are held at TDSB school locations across the city. Ther are a variety of times to train (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday at lunch, or Monday and Wednesday after school or Tuesday and Thursday mornings) in order to meet the various schedules of all our students. We run rain or shine so please dress appropriately. Your child <u>must</u> be able to run the whole distance continuously to participate in the Meet.
