



SO YOU'RE GOING INTO GRADE 10

CEDARBRAE COLLEGIATE INSTITUTE COURSE SELECTION FOR 2026-2027

For Students Moving from Grade 9 to Grade 10

Students moving from Grade 9 to Grade 10 must choose a total of 8 courses and 3 alternatives: **Regular Program** – include a minimum of 5 compulsory courses plus 3 elective courses and 3 alternative courses.

Immersion and Extended students – include a minimum of 6 compulsory courses plus 2 elective courses and 3 alternative courses.

When choosing the codes for your compulsory courses keep in mind that the 5th and bolded letter in each of the codes listed above indicates the **level** at which the course is offered: **D**- Academic, **O**- Open. Many of the Grade 10 elective courses are offered at the open level and do not require a prerequisite. Make sure you have the prerequisite for the courses you are choosing. If a student fails a grade 9 core course (English, Math, Science, Geography, French) than they need to put this into their timetable for next year. If they want to complete the course before September, they can sign up for summer school and when the student has passed summer school their timetable for next year will be changed (i.e., put in the appropriate grade 10 course)

The choice of remaining **elective courses and alternative courses** should be made with the following in mind:

- Check that you have the prerequisites for the courses you are interested in.
- Your interests, your skills, and your career ideas.
- Other diploma requirements (check your Student Status Sheet). One example would be the new diploma requirement of 1 STEM related course.

STEM-related course group: you must complete 1 from the following group:

- business studies
- computer studies
- cooperative education
- mathematics (in addition to the 3 compulsory credits currently required)
- science (in addition to the 2 compulsory credits currently required)
- technological education (in addition to the 1 compulsory credit required)
