Dear Parents/Guardians:

Good news! Cedarbrook will be having the rear pavement and parking lot redone, under the supervision of TDSB Facilities Services. This pavement replacement is badly needed as it is crumbling and cracking. The lower pavement will be replaced, and new equipment (e.g. tri-hoops and basketball nets) will be installed. New trees will also be planted along the edge of the pavement.

There will be two phases of construction so that this project is completed by September 2026. The first phase will begin on May 11th, 2026, and continue to June 25, 2026. Construction fences will be put up on the back pavement after 4 p.m. on May 8th. These fences will close the upper and lower pavements from Door 6 all the way to the parking lot. There will be **no access** from the parking lot to the back of the school. There will also be **no direct access** to the field from the pavement. To access the pavement at the back of the school, students/parents will need to use either the ramp from the sidewalk coming from Farmbrook Road or the pathway at the front of the school by the Kindergarten Yard near Door 7.

Due to the construction fences, classroom line-ups and school entry/exit will need to be changed. More information regarding student pick-up/drop off locations and field access will be coming soon. Kindergarten entry remains the same.

Phase two of this construction project will begin once students are finished on June 25th. At this time, the entire lower pavement and the parking lot will be fenced off and there will be no access to either area.

As you can imagine, there is a lot of work to be done in the next few months, and efforts are being made to reduce any inconveniences to our school community when possible.

I appreciate your patience and cooperation throughout the different construction phases. While some inconvenience is inevitable, I know we all agree that the end result will bring many benefits to our students as well as the local community for many years to come.
