## Central Technical School

### Examination Information for Students

The following rules apply to all examinations at Central Technical School.

| <b>Absences</b>         | If you miss an exam, you must present a medical certificate or court order stating why you were unable to be present for the exam. A medical certificate must be dated on the same day as the missed exam and must say that the doctor is aware that it is an exam missed. In a serious family emergency, the Principal or Vice-Principal must be contacted. Documentation must be received by the office one day after the missed evaluation. Otherwise a mark of (0) will be assigned for the exam.  |
| <b>Admission</b>        | You are not allowed to enter an examination room until the teacher in-charge admits you.   |
| <b>Text Books</b>       | Return course textbooks according to your teacher's instructions. Remember to initial upon return  |
| <b>Notes</b>            | Leave all other textbooks, notes, and school bags in front of the class room during examination.   |
| <b>Bags, phones</b>     | <b>Cell phones, iPods and other valuable electronics should not be brought to exam room.</b>   |
| <b>Lateness</b>         | If you arrive late for an examination, you will be admitted to the exam but will not be given extra time for writing. If you arrive after 9:15a.m. go to the VP office to get a late slip. If you arrive after 10:00 a.m. See a VP.  |
| <b>Academic Honesty</b> | Cheating is an act that could lead to a student obtaining marks through fraud or dishonesty.<br>Examples of cheating include, but are not limited to: 1) communicating with another student 2) providing material for another student 3) Looking at another student's work 4) copying another student's work 5) bringing unauthorized material into the exam room 6) possessing unauthorized aids. The supervising teacher must report incidents of cheating to the Principal or Vice- Principal for investigation. There will be a penalty for cheating which may result in a mark of (0) for the full exam. This could result in a failing mark in a course. |
| <b>Talking</b>          | You must not talk to other students from the beginning of the exam until all examinations have been collected at the conclusion of the scheduled time. If you talk during an exam, you will be presumed to be cheating and may be assigned a mark of (0) for the full exam.  |
| <b>Exam Pages</b>       | <u>Number and sign exam papers with your name and course title. Arrange them in numerical order.</u>   |
| <b>Dismissal</b>        | <b>You must stay for the first hour of the full exam.</b> You may then leave an exam room at scheduled half hour interval thereafter, before the end of the scheduled time. You must sit quietly until you are dismissed. If you do not remain silent until dismissal, you may have your exam removed and a mark of (0) given for your exam. Please be courteous to other students – once you have been dismissed from an exam, please leave the building quickly and quietly so as not to disturb others who may still be writing other exams.  |

- **ESL & ELL Students and Students with IEP's are entitled to extra time, up to double the time for writing exams.**
