As we welcome the new year we hope that everyone enjoyed the holidays and are ready to move forward with remote learning.

Students are expected to attend classes regularly. Regular attendance supports student success. Students are expected to engage in class activities either through use of their camera, microphone and or chat box.

During the remote learning period both cohorts will attend all synchronous learning sessions. There will be no divide for cohort A and cohort B. There-

fore there will be no asynchronous period for students to sign in for attendance purposes. Students will meet with their teacher as scheduled each day.

Attendance is taken by the teacher twice a day for students who are learning synchronously both at 8:45am and at 2:00pm. Calls will go out to parents/guardians to notify them about their child's attendance in the morning and afternoon periods.

Parents/guardians and students will be

informed during the week of January 4 to January 8 of their mid term mark.

Teachers are expected to provide regular communication to students and parents/guardians. Teachers will share a "mark to date" at the midpoint of the course for quad 2 to ensure that students and families receive accurate information about a student's progress and a focus on improvement prior to the end of the course. The teachers will share student progress with students and families electronically.
