# Apprenticeships

## Earn While You Learn!

- An **apprentice** is someone who is learning a trade and has a formal training contract with a sponsor.
- A **sponsor** is the journeyperson, group, or organization responsible for providing the apprentice with training experiences.
- A **journeyperson** is someone who is fully certified in their trade, can perform all the work in that trade without supervision, and can also train new apprentices.

# Skilled Trades & Apprenticeship Sectors

**150 options in Ontario ~ 360 in Canada**



- **CONSTRUCTION** – construction trades, as well as heavy equipment operator, mobile crane operators, powerline technicians
- **INDUSTRIAL** – trades with machinery, as well as surface blaster, tool & die, CNC precision, welders, process operators
- **MOTIVE POWER** – trades with vehicles, mechanics, heavy equipment technician
- **SERVICE** – chef, baker, hair stylist, educational assistant, arborist, horse groomer

# It Can Take 2-5 Years

So, you're thinking of becoming a Plumber?

- **On-the-job-training:** 10 to 12 months
  - **In-class training:** 155 hrs of theory + 85 hrs of hands-on = 240 hrs
- **On-the-job-training:** 10 to 12 months
  - **In-class training:** 146 hrs of theory + 94 hrs of hands-on = 240 hrs
- **On-the-job-training:** 10 to 12 months
  - **In-class training:** 170 hrs of theory + 70 hrs of hands-on = 240 hrs
- Write the **Certificate of Qualification** exam

## **Diploma & Advanced Diploma**

**Programs:** Three Grade 11 or 12 C, M or U courses, plus ENG4C/ENG4U1

**Degree Programs:** Six Grade 12 U/M Courses, including ENG4U1

Program specific requirements

Supplementary applications, portfolios, interviews, etc.

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# College Application Process

Applications are now open!

**Deadline for Equal Consideration: February 1, 2022**

**Note that applications to *Highly Competitive Programs* must be received by this date in order to be considered.**

**examples: Nursing, Dental Hygiene, Paramedic**

\$95 for **five** program choices (max. 3 choices at one college)



# University Admission Requirements



Ontario Secondary School Diploma

Six Grade 12 U or M courses

ENG4U1 - included in the 6 courses

Program specific requirements

Supplementary applications,  
portfolios, interviews, etc.

Grade 11 marks *may* be considered  
for early admission into some highly  
competitive programs



# University Application Process

**November , 2021**

- OUAC PIN letters mailed to your home address and will also be available for pick-up in the Guidance Office. **Make sure the school has your correct mailing address.**
- The PIN allows you to create an account in order to apply to Ontario universities.

OUAC applications open at the end of November.

# The Application Fee \$

- \$150 for three university/program choices
- \$50 for each additional university/program choice
- Supplemental program fees may be required
- Payable online by Visa, Mastercard, American Express or online banking
- Google form will be made available for students who need help to pay the application fee. See Guidance Google Classroom or your counsellor for more information.

# Application Deadline



**Application deadline or Equal Consideration date is JANUARY 13, 2022**

What is Equal Consideration?

Apply on or before this date in order to receive equal consideration for admission to programs starting the following fall. After this date, universities consider applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until programs are full.

**Note that applications to *Highly Competitive Programs* must be received by this date in order to be considered.**

**examples: McMaster Health Sciences, Waterloo Software & Biomedical Engineering, Queen's Commerce**

# Research, Research, Research

- Take virtual campus tours & register for open houses
- Talk to teachers, guidance counsellors, parents/guardians, family, mentors
- Compare programs & narrow down selections - make a list
- If required, prepare for supplemental application early
- Give teachers 1-2 weeks to prepare reference letters
- Plan your finances! Look for information on scholarships, bursaries & OSAP
- University/College Virtual Visits - posted in google classroom

# After you Apply: <sup>What</sup> Next?

- ❑ Log into your account and verify details. Review and make any changes
- ❑ Set your spam filters to accept emails from OUAC & OCAS
- ❑ **If you have taken a course outside TDSB, submit final report to your counsellor**
- ❑ **Check your marks are accurately reflected in OUAC**
- ❑ Maintain your average. Offers are conditional and can be revoked. Know the disclosure dates.
- ❑ Research how you are going to fund your education; OSAP, Scholarships, Bursaries
- ❑ Research if you will live on or off campus
- ❑ If you enrol in a course from a private school, they must send your mark to OUAC & OCAS

## What is OSAP?

The Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) is a financial aid program that can help you pay for college or university. OSAP offers funding through 2 ways:

1. **Grants** - money you don't have to pay back
2. **Loans** - money you pay back once completed school

Use the **OSAP calculator** to estimate how much you are entitled to.
