## Principal's Report

School Improvement

- Data and student census
- Students feeling safe, heard and seen and can express their identity
- $65 \%$ of students/parents completed the census
- Mostly students and parents are happy with the school, safety and wellbeing
- Some segments of children feeling lonely or that they aren't being heard by adults (small percentage 15-20\%)
- What can be done to improve this small percent


## Caring and Safe Schools

- Some behaviour difficulties - grade 5 - issue with Discord chat application
- Small group using chat
- Bullying, inappropriate usage
- Meetings with students and parents to discuss this
- Community resource officer to speak about (tentative)
- Internet etiquette
- Child and youth social worker and councillor to address grade 5-6
- Multilingual learner students
- Dealing with language/cultural barriers, etc

Staffing

- 0.5 EA in morning and 0.5 SNA in afternoon working out well
- After March Break, teaching allocation with number of teachers
- September numbers projection is 175 students (last year was 165)
- Classroom organization
- Rationalization of organization

Budget

- Spent $70 \%$ of budget - so still have $1 / 2$ March, April, May, June to go
- $\$ 3000 /$ month to spend and leave $\$ 1000$ for over the summer expenses
