#### 6. Principals Update

- Focus on literacy or numeracy we are focusing on literacy
- EQAO data only a snapshot and only one part of the puzzle when looking at our students' progress
- Literacy stayed same from grade 3 to grade 6 (70-80%)
- Math not as good provincial wide problem
- Literacy focused PD for teachers
- Teachers to target reading instruction to get students to where they need to be
- Ms. So and Ms. Munroe doing reading assessments
- DRA kit (reading assessment kit junior and intermediate students)
- Need for reading fluency
  - o Reading for meaning
  - Reading punctuation, emphasis and fluidity
  - Student can tell you about the article, point of view, author, purpose, etc.
- 1/2 of robotics order has come in
- SCAs MR. Kwan (Grade 5/6) Chair
  - France is parent rep
  - o Areas of inclusion, acceptance, kindness and community
  - Learning how to problem solve,
  - o Conflict resolution skills
  - Ms. Zupo non-teaching staff rep
- Staffing issues -
  - Slowly filling lunchroom supervisor roster
  - Problems across the board with staffing issues
- Budget going quickly
  - o Smaller school, fewer students, less money to work with
  - Literacy resources
  - Technology for teachers
  - o Few thousand left for summer expenses
  - Kindergarten outdoor play equipment needed for gross motor skills

- (shed toys belong to daycare)
- o Jr literacy resources
  - Some students not reading and not working at literacy grade level
  - Purchase resources for junior engagement and reading level
- PhysEd equipment softball and cricket equipment
- Grade 6 outdoor education trip
- Student fundraising supports financial literacy as well

Mr. Kwan – will be attending French literacy PD

Special education trained teachers (SPEC Ed)

- Lead teachers are Ms. Munroe and Ms. So (also Mrs. Grant and Mrs. Elbertsen (Part 1))
- Mr. Montuno & Mr. Kwan signed up to do part 2
- Ontario College of teacher site type up their names and find out qualifications and background
