SAC Budget

- All classes have booked Scientists in the Classroom
- School bus budget for each class has increased to \$300
- \$1000 for DD and DK see-saw, toys, 2 play mats, large building blocks,
- \$100 towards sports
- \$100 toward Mr. Kwan and Mr. Montuno each for their classes
- African drummer (<\$400), CNY Lion dance

Wish list

- Board with stand for school (Ms. Nivins) - \$300
- Track and field – fun day and competitive day – one bus from school budget
- White boards in the classroom – option of roll out/wall paper – permanent (can potentially bubble over time, can stain quicker, but much more cost effective than actual hard, white board)
 - Potentially purchase a few first
- Fall – need for student devices
- New Jerseys for next year for cross country
- Colour printer – DD, DK, kindergarten – at least \$700 – long term cost of colour printer is a concern
 - Only Grand & Toy is TDSB approved vendor
 - (may be a school board rate)
 - Cartridge cost needs to be taken into account
 - Will help with visual schedules, picture symbols for kids to see themselves in the space – for DD, DK and Kindergarten
- Ms. Wai's class was gifted 13 reading programs for her class
 - registration is \$26 /student
 - Can we cover cost for Ms. Tselios class = \$624
 - Will this be used in class, etc?
 - Are parents active at home to use as well
 - Can we cover half of the cost
 - Agreed – to cover half and license will be good for rest of this school year and all of next school year

 - Ms. Bemat - on medical leave
 - Ms. Chan - on medical leave
 - Staffing process for the coming year has begun
 - Projections for 2025 students given and allocations received for 2025 staff
- SCHOOL Budget at 80% already spent
 - ENSURING ALL teachers have working technology including ECEs, etc
 - gym equipment, and other incidentals i.e., equipment for DK and DD, safety items
 - Occasional teachers
- Extra-Curricular
 - Junior Boys BB, Junior Girls VB,
 - Forest Valley gr. 1 and 3/4,
 - Gr. 6 overnight trip
 - Jays Care baseball equipment & Cricket equipment,
 - ED club, Student Council, Track and Field in the spring

- Budget needs - Gross motor/sensory room for ISPs
 - o Build gross motor room for DD and DK
 - o Another space in the building – potentially music space
 - Spec ed resource program can be done in any space
 - o Canada Post Grant submitted
 - \$5000 – Mrs. Grant wrote and applied for grant with help from OT/PT
