**What will the Daily Health Screening process look like?**



Staff and students must conduct daily Covid-19 self-assessments at home prior to attending school.

**Toronto Public Health protocols state staff and students must remain at home if they have one (1) COVID-19 symptom.**

The TDSB Health Screening App will be used for at-home screening every morning prior to leaving home. This will allow for quicker entrance into the school.

All students are expected to wear a mask/face covering to protect others and reduce the spread of Covid-19.

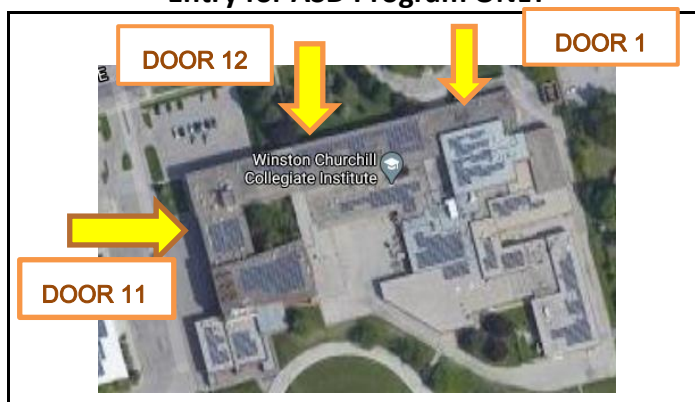
**DAILY ENTRY**  
**Where do students enter the school?**

There are two entrances for student use. Staff will greet students and complete verification upon arrival at each entrance.

**DOOR #11**(west side parking lot)  
**Entry for classes on second floor**

**DOOR #12** (NOT main door)  
**Entry for classes on first floor**

**DOOR #1** (main front doors)  
**Entry for ASD Program ONLY**

**(after 9:00am)**














**After 9:15am** please enter through the main front doors and proceed to the main office for student late arrival sign-in.




**END OF DAY**
