RE: Solar Panel Installation

We are excited to tell you that Winston Churchill will have a solar panel installed on its roof this year. Construction will begin in Saturday, October 28th, 2017 and is expected to be completed in about 10 weeks. During this time you will see some construction taking place around the school which includes installation of 960 Solar PV panels on the school roof. There will be a fenced area on the ground during the time to protect students from the construction activities at the ground level. It is anticipated that construction will have no impact on the operation of the school.

The Solar Schools Project, which started in September 2017, is an exciting initiative that will see solar panels installed on the roofs of 60 TDSB schools. As one of the greenest school boards in Canada, we're proud that this project will generate energy equivalent to the amount used annually by about 1,100 households in Toronto.

The revenue generated from the solar panel installation will be used to fund roof repairs and replacements for TDSB schools.

Our teachers will be able to take advantage of the solar infrastructure that will be built to engage your child in the ongoing debate about the global impact of energy use on the environment and in particular, the specific decisions that need to be made in Ontario to reduce the impact of our own energy consumption.
