**Attendance:**

Remember the time and location of each of your examinations. Highlight the examinations you are to write, then fill in your personal timetable noting the subject, date and time of exam and the location. **It is the student's responsibility to be at the correct place at the correct time for each of their examinations.** If in doubt ask your subject teacher for the location and date of your examination. Each day's schedule will be posted in the front hall.

**Lates:**

Students who are late for examinations should go directly to their exam room. **No extra time will be given to a student arriving late for an examination.**

**Missed Examinations:**

Students who miss examinations due to illness **MUST** bring a Medical Certificate dated the day of the missed exam and indicating that the student was 'too ill to write the exam', to the Vice-Principal. Failure to provide a Doctor's Certificate to the Vice-Principal will result in a mark of zero for the missed examination. No make-up examinations will be permitted.

**Examination Conflicts:**

A conflict is defined as two regular examinations scheduled at the same time. Students who have examination conflicts must complete an Exam Conflict form by **Thursday January 17** available in the main office.

**Library:**

Our library is open for quiet individual study. Students not respecting this quiet rule will be asked to leave. The library will be open from 8:30 to 12:15.

**Student Expectations:**

- ▶ Coats and bags must be left at the front of the classroom.
- ▶ Students must supply their own pens, pencils, rulers, erasers, math sets, calculator and other materials required for their examination. Students may NOT share materials.
- ▶ Students cannot leave the examination room at any time during the examination and must remain in the examination room for one full hour. Washroom emergencies will be supervised by an "on call" teacher.
- ▶ Students must not linger in the halls or corridors after their examinations, as other students may still be completing their examinations.
- ▶ Students may NOT use cell phones, headsets, or other electronic devices in the exam room. NO food or drinks will be permitted in the exam room.

**Academic Honesty:**

Students will not have access to any unauthorized materials which might be of assistance to them in writing the examination. Students who are caught cheating will be given a mark of **ZERO** for the examination and may be subject to other disciplinary action by the Vice-Principal.
