## Absence Reporting

## 1-833-250-2290



To help streamline the student absence reporting process, a change has been made to the Safe

Arrival option when the school phone number is dialed.

Effective immediately, when the Safe Arrival option is selected, the call will be transferred directly to the School Messenger phone system. (Parents/Guardians can still call the 1-833-250-2290 directly and receive the same options.)

Depending on the phone number they are calling from, callers may hear one of the following messages:

#### Calling from a phone number registered in PowerSchool

- Parent/Guardian calls main school number and listens to the welcome message
- To report a student absence, press 1 (can be 2 or 3 depending on your specific school) (caller hears "Wait while I transfer your call")
- Then "Welcome to School Messenger notification system for Toronto District School Board"
- For student attendance, press 3
- For student A in grade..., press 2
- For student B in grade..., press 3
- For student C in grade..., press 4

#### Calling from a phone number <u>not</u> registered in PowerSchool

- Parent calls main school number and listens to the welcome message
- To report a student absence, press 1 (can be 2 or 3 depending on your specific school) (caller hears "Wait while I transfer your call")
- "Welcome to School Messenger notification system for Toronto District School Board"
- For student attendance, press 3
- Please enter a phone number that you have registered with a school
- If phone number is registered then parents/

guardians will be able to pick the student and report the absence

• If the phone number is not registered then they will receive the message "This phone number does not have any children registered to it". Parents/guardians will need to call the school and update data in the Student Information System.

The TDSB wants to hear your questions and concerns, and makes every effort to address them as quickly as possible.

In any situation, your child's classroom teacher is the first point of contact, followed by the school's principal, the school superintendent and your Trustee.


