With regards to school programming on Friday, it will be asynchronous and not virtual. We are still waiting for more specific direction regarding the academic program for Friday and it will be shared with our students and families once finalized.

We continue to hope to provide such opportunities for your children. A major point of focus across the TDSB this year is to place emphasis on student engagement and joy and that will remain a focus of ours as we proceed through the school year.
