School Organization:

The classrooms, staff, and schedules that start a school year are crated based upon a school's projected enrolment. In the TDSB, schools receive their projected enrolment in the late winter of the previous school year. In the past, the formulae used by the TDSB planning department to determine upcoming enrolment numbers had proven to be extremely accurate overall. However, as in all aspects of our lives, the pandemic made things harder to predict. According to projections, Clinton Street PS was expected to have 291 students this year. After taking very careful attendance this week, we are starting the year with 321 students. We will not be informed for another week if there will be any change to our current classroom configuration or staff. We will keep you informed if anything changes, and the schedule by which those changes are to be implemented.

School Communication:

We consistently update the website so that it is the main source for school-wide information. The school's calendar is also accessible via the website to keep you updated on whole-school or multi-class events (Photo Day – Oct. 2). Classroom teachers will communicate with their families regarding items more specific to their classrooms. We are a busy school and strive to keep you informed of all the activity.

Transportation:

Roughly half of the families at Clinton Street PS rely on TDSB transportation services to safely get their child(ren) to and from school.

There are roughly a dozen different vehicles that service our school each day.

We place a great emphasis on ensuring that our students disembark and board the buses safely. The front entrance to our school from Manning Ave. is the drop-off and pick-up location for our buses. If you are driving your child to school, you might want to consider picking a location on the Clinton Street side for drop off and pick up.

Please remember that no member of the Clinton Street PS staff creates or co-ordinates the transportation schedule.

Transportation requests are submitted to the TDSB Transportation office for consideration and requests are either approved or denied by the Transportation Department.

For this year, the busing schedule is to commence as follows:

September 5: Transportation begins for all Clinton Street PS Special Needs Students (excluding gifted) who travel to school on minibuses, minivans, taxis, and wheelchair-accessible vehicles

September 11: All remaining students and programs will start transportation assuming there are no significant challenges with driver recruitment
